The Balmoral Swim for Cancer Schools Relay in 2016 was another great success!

5 schools, 62 teams, great conditions, sportsmanship, some amazing swimming, and impressive attitude!

There were three age relays – Junior, Intermediate & Senior

The point-score results from the Junior Age race:

1. Riverview 24 points
2. Wenona 11 points
3. Queenwood 10 points

The point-score results from the Intermediate Age race:

1. Shore 15 points
2. Mosman High 9 points
3. Wenona & Riverview 8 points

The point-score results from the Senior Age race:

1. Shore & Riverview 19 points
2. Queenwood 5 points
3. Wenona 3 points

Riverview had the highest overall score across the age divisions and won the School Relay Challenge Shield for the second year in a row.

Mosman entered for the second year running and had a great result in the Intermediate Age relay, we look forward to seeing a team in each division next year.

As the organisers we see the relay having two core objectives:

1. Fun
2. Fundraising

Having our next generation taking a pivotal role in charitable work is a great learning experience.
